The Philomath Community Foundation will award the Cody James Patterson Memorial Scholarship annually to a graduating senior from Philomath High School who wishes to further his/her education. Emphasis will be placed on the attributes that Cody emulated during his brief life: leadership, dependability, sportsmanship, citizenship, and participation in high school athletic programs, as well as standing among high school peers and staff, will be the measures that will be used to select the annual recipient.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 and be eligible to graduate from Philomath High School during the current academic year.
2. Attend Philomath High School for 2 academic years.
3. Applicant must have participated in at least one Philomath High School athletic program.
4. Attach a copy of your high school transcript.
